2018 CLOVIS WEST SWIMMING AND DIVING INVITATIONAL SITE OF THE CIF STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS FRIDAY AND SATURDAY, APRIL 6-7, 2018

Greetings Coach and Athletic Director:

Below you will find information for our 2018 Swimming and Diving Invitational. Read the material carefully. We have several major changes in the meet format as well as new due dates! If you have questions, be sure to give us a call! Please make arrangements now for the payment of the entry fees, keeping swimming and diving checks separate! Do not mail the fees, but bring the check(s) on the day of competition. Personal checks are accepted.

Coaches- please check that your swimmers meet the qualifying standards listed below. This meet is **not** meant for a beginning swimmer! "No Times" (NT) will <u>not</u> be accepted or entered into the meet at either J.V. or Varsity levels. Our timeline depends upon every coach adhering to these time standards. Varsity will be on the South end of the pool and JV on the North side. The number of lanes used for each end will be determined based on timelines.

Important info for 2018:

- New email for entry files: kgruce@gmail.com
- There will be only Varsity diving (11 dives). There will no longer be a JV diving division of 6 dives.
- Diving names MUST be submitted with hy-tek file with swim entries. Dive list changes are not due until 30 min before start of event. We will be using www.divemeets.com for dive list entries.
- Varsity teams may enter up to **6 swimmers** in the 200 I.M. and 200 free.
- JV teams may enter **4 swimmers** in the 200 I.M. and 200 free.
- There are unlimited entries in all other individual events. Teams may enter A, B, C, and D relays.
- Because of the size of the meet and the time needed to prepare heat sheets and programs, <u>our due date</u> for the meet will be Tuesday. March 27th. Coaches: note that this is over 1 ½ weeks ahead of the meet date.
- Late entries may be denied. The decision will be determined by the number of athletes entered in the meet by the due date. Last priority will go to teams with late entries.
- Individual and relay events will score the top 18 places.
- Only the fastest TWO heats of varsity boys and girls 500 free will be swum on Saturday. All other heats will be swum Friday night following all of the heats of Junior Varsity 500 freestyle. Access our website on Tuesday, April 3rd, and check on the status of your varsity 500 swimmers and when they will swim make sure your athlete is prepared to swim Friday evening. Entries will not be changed for a swimmer entered in any event, including the 500 free.
- The meet will begin at **5:00 PM** on Friday and at **8:30 AM** on Saturday.

Parking- due to school being in session on Friday, please park in back parking lot off Cole Ave.

Please let your parents know that a spectator fee will be charged on competition days. CW invite T-Shirts will be on sale.

Entries: All entries must be done using Hy-Tek. The information to download Hy-Tek Lite is available on this website. Click on the link, "CW Invite", click on the link, "Entry Instructions".

Diving Competition- Diving entries will use online entry using www.divemeets.com. For the guidelines and complete time-line, refer to the Diving Information sheet on www.cloviswestaquatics.com. Diver names must be included in the hy-tek team file with the swimming events. Any dive only teams must email diver name, gender, and year in school to adamreid@cusd.com to ensure they get into the meet.

Warm-ups: Friday's competitors will be available at 4:00 PM. **Team warm ups for all others** will be available from 5:30PM until 7:30 PM Friday evening. Saturday warm up will start at 7:00 AM.

Rules- All 2017-2018 High School Swimming and Diving Rules will apply. Each swimmer may enter in only one division. Each competitor is limited to the number of events as described in the National Federation Rules book.

Scoring- Individual events: 22-19-18-17-16-15-14-13-12-10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 Relays shall be doubled.

Team Awards-

- First and second place team awards: Varsity boys and girls, and J.V. boys and girls.
- First overall combined team total
- "Most Outstanding" male and female varsity swimmers. Winners will be based upon total individual points scored.

Entry Fees- \$100.00 per division entered. If all four divisions are entered, the cost is reduced to \$350. A \$50 late charge will be added if fees have not been paid by the beginning of competition. Please make checks payable to "Clovis West Swimming". Meet fees will be collected at the pool office on competition day before picking up coach packet. **(Please do not mail your fees!)**

A \$15.00 charge <u>per diver</u> will be assessed. This must be paid on the deck <u>prior</u> to the start of diving on Friday. No diver will be allowed to participate without paying this fee. Please pass this information on to your diving coach and diving athletes.

Team Entries- Entries <u>must</u> be submitted using Hy-Tek, and the information on how to download Hy-Tek Lite is available on our website. Hytek meet file will also be available on the website (<u>www.cloviswestaquatics.com</u>). If you have any problems entering, call Adam Reid immediately. **Please include the grade of the swimmer.** This is an USA Swimming observed meet. <u>If athletes want to have their swims observed for USA swimming SWIMS database</u>, please include their USA swimming ID number in your team database.

- > Be sure to give us a phone number where you can be reached in case we have questions regarding your entries.
- > Scratches may be done on an official scratch form provided at the meet Saturday morning or if you know of any scratches beforehand please email them to Keith Gruce (kgruce@gmail.com).

Please submit your entries as early as possible. We must have all entries in our hands on Tuesday, March 27th. The computer work for seeding will begin at that time. We would appreciate any early entries!

Coaches: On the previous page the Varsity time standards are listed. If an athlete cannot meet or exceed these standards, please enter them in the Junior Varsity meet. Do <u>not</u> enter any athlete with a "No Time" (NT). Again, our time line depends upon coaches following the entry times.

Other than the 500 free, there are no official time standards for the <u>Junior Varsity</u>. Please do not enter an athlete in an event that they cannot **finish** in a reasonable amount of time or have the skills to complete.
