Meet Entries: All coaches are expected to use the Hy-tek program to enter their swimmers and divers. If you do not have the program, you may go to <u>www.hy-tekltd.com</u> and download a free copy of the program by clicking on download center and download Swimming Demo Team Manager II Lite (free). The event file will be posted at http://www.cloviswestaquatics.com download the file and fully enter your athletes. A pdf copy of your team entries needs to be submitted with the Hytek file as a back up for clerical mistakes. Please review your pdf to make sure there are no errors in events entered. Events will not be changed once psych sheet is posted on the website.

- Please include school name, athlete's first and last names, current year in school (Fr, So, Jr, Sr), event(s), and provable time(s).
- If you have club swimmers that would like to have their swim observed, please include their USS swimming ID in your Team Manager entry file. There are new USS numbers this year. There will also be a sign-up book at the meet for athletes to add USS ID.

Meet Entries continued:

- Entries are due by Sunday, May 4, at 12:00 noon. <u>This includes diving entries</u>. Please include divers in your entries.
- Late entries will not be accepted. Preliminary entries will be posted on the website by 4:00 pm on Sunday, May 4. Corrections must be made Monday, May 5, by 10:00 am. This is not the final entries.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU INCLUDE A PHONE CONTACT IN YOUR EMAIL SO WE MAY GET A HOLD OF SOMEONE IN CASE OF ISSUES WITH ENTRIES.

Each team will be permitted a maximum of four entries in an individual event and one relay team per relay event. A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of two individual events and two relay events, or one individual event and three relays. Coaches must enter alternates on the relays (up to 4). Each relay can have up to 8 names listed. Relay swims will not count against the swimmer entry count until they swim in prelims or finals. If a relay qualifies for CIF State Championships, a new set of 8 names can be submitted to meet management at the end of the CIF Section meet before leaving the pool deck.

Swimming prelims will run 10 lanes. Consideration times will be used to fill to 40 athletes per event. Swimming finals will be 8 lanes with top 16 qualifying for finals.

Dive Entries

Dive entries must be entered with the Hytek team swimming & diving entry on *Sunday, May 4, by 12:00 p.m.* along with the swim entries. Dive sheets with score, League results, or invitational results showing proof of qualifying score need to be emailed to adamreid@cusd.com. Qualified diving competitors will be able to submit dive sheets with their eleven dive list on www.divemeets.com starting on *Monday, May 5, at 8:00 a.m.* Dive sheet entry through www.divemeets.com will close on *Tuesday, May 6, at 12:00 p.m.* Entries for all swimmers & divers will close and are final, except for circumstance of clerical error, at *12:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 4*.

No other entry additions will be accepted after the *Sunday* deadline of 12:00 p.m. <mark>Divemeets.com</mark> is strictly a dive list and not an official entry into the meet. Hytek files are the official entry.

Dive sheets must be filled out according to C.I.F. regulations. Please see the www.divemeets.com help section if you have any questions. No handwritten score sheets will be accepted as entries. Changes to the dive list will be permitted up to 30 minutes prior to the beginning of a given event. Notice will be given over the P.A. system prior to the closing of that time period. During competition, there will be cuts following the fifth (20 divers) and eighth round (16 divers). In the event that there are more than 32 divers, there will be a cut at round three to 32 divers.

Entry Fees: The entry fee is \$2.00 for each individual swim and/or diving event entered. Relays are \$8.00. Any swimmer listed as an alternate for relays is charged \$2.00 per relay listed. Please make sure that they are included in your database file. (ex) An athlete entered in the 100 fly, 500 free, and two relays will be charged \$8.00 – or \$2.00 per entry. An athlete listed as an alternate on two relays will be charged \$4.00 – or \$2.00 per entry. No athlete will be charged more than \$8.00. Please remember that an athlete may not swim in a relay if they are not officially entered into the meet. <u>CIF will bill schools the amount for their entry fees. You do not bring a check to the meet.</u>

Rules: The meet will be run accordance with the National Federation Rule book and the CIF Central Section Swimming & Diving Regulations. The CIF regulations can be found at <u>www.cifcs.org</u>

Qualification: All swimming qualifying times must have been equaled or bettered at a 2025 CIF sanctioned dual meet, invitational, or championship meet. Time trials, club meets, or exhibition swims <u>cannot</u> be used. Swimmers/relays must be entered with their best time for the 2025 season. All coaches must be prepared to show meet results as proof that the time standard has been achieved in accordance with the rules.

Only approved CIF & State <u>Play-Off</u> & Lifetime Passes will be honored.

Suit policy: Deck Changing is not permitted by NFHS rules. Locker rooms will be available for changing. *Two-piece suits are NOT permitted on deck or in the warmup pool.*

Parking Info: Dive parking on Wednesday & Thursday will be free in the main lot off Teague and Millbrook. All swim parking for Friday & Saturday can be accessed off the Millbrook/Cole intersection. Swim parking will not be permitted in the main lot off Teague and Millbrook. There will be a \$5.00 general parking fee at the facility on Friday and Saturday for all cars and school vans. This will include cars with handicap passes. RV's will not be allowed on school grounds during any day of competition. School Buses can drop athletes off near pool entrance but will exit lot and park on the street. All vehicles entering the lot will be charged \$5. Athletes needing to be dropped off will use the Drop Off Area on Teague Ave (area west of track). Parking will open at 9:30 am on Friday, May 9, and 7:30 am Saturday, May 10. See attached Parking Map.

Facilities: Restrooms and showers are provided on premises. Please do not leave personal items unattended in these areas. Shaving on site is not permitted.

Snack Bar: A snack bar and food vendors will be on site for your convenience breakfast, lunch, snacks, and drinks will be available for a reasonable price. Hospitality will be provided for all coaches and officials.

Commemorative T-Shirts: A vendor will be on site to sell t-shirts.

Swim Suits and Accessories: Elsmore Swim Shop will be on site to sell caps, goggles, suits, and other swimming accessories.

Awards: Team awards will be given to the top two teams for boys and girls in Division 1. Top 8 individual/relay places will receive awards.

State Qualification: The top 3 placers from CIF Central Section Championships (combined D1 & D2) for individual and relay swimming events will be eligible for advancement to the CIF State Championships. Athletes must declare at the Section Championship meet their intent to compete at the State Championships. If one of the top 3 placers declines, the Section will send the next eligible athlete. For diving, CIF Central Section will advance the top 4 placers (combined D1 & D2) from the State Dive Qualifier on May 7 to the CIF State Championship. Divers must confirm on the commitment sheet that they will attend the CIF State Championship at the CIF Section Championship. The top 4 divers from each division will advance to the State Qualification meet.
